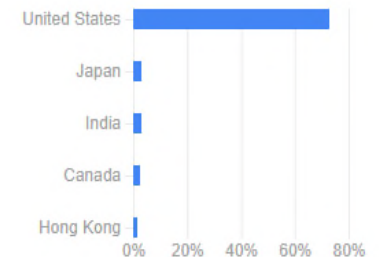
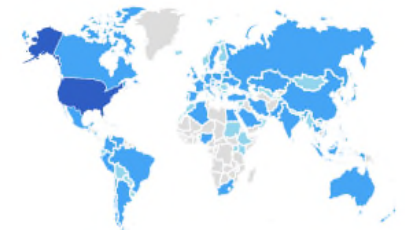

Since our 2019 Annual Meeting, we have received notifications that the following Fellows have passed away. These Fellows would have been memorialized during our Annual Meeting:



Gary L. Schechter, MD

January 12, 1939 – September 15, 2018

- 1992 Inductee as Active Fellow with Emeritus elevation in 2007
- 1963 Graduate (Summa Cum Laude -1st in class) from SUNY College of Medicine
- Served with the U.S. Public Health Service hospitals from 1964-1967
- Completed Residency and NINDS Training Fellowship at Washington University of St. Louis in 1970
- Began professional career at UTMB, Galveston, TX in 1970
- Became Founding Chair of the ENT Department at Eastern Virginia Med. School in 1972 until retirement in 1999
- Accomplishments include developing a Residency program, research division, hearing and balance center with recognition of being a leading Head & Neck Cancer program.
- Member of numerous state and national medical organizations (TRIO, ABEA, ABOto)



Stanley Thawley, MD

May 23, 1943 – January 22, 2019



- Inducted as an Active Fellow in 19823 and elevated to Emeritus Fellowship in 2013
- Medical Degree earned at the University of Minnesota Medical School with internship at Parkland Hospital, Dallas, TX and ENT residency at Barnes Hospital
- Joined faculty at the University of Washington of St. Louis in 1975 where he achieved the rank of Professor of Otolaryngology and served as Chief of OTO at the VA Medical Center
- In late 1980's, became Director of the Sinus Allergy Division & Director of Adult Division in Otolaryngology
- Director of the AAOA Residency Training & Fellowship Committee
- Editor of *The Laryngoscope*
- Member of several state and national associations including the Triological Society, American Otological Society, and the American Board of Otolaryngology
- In 2017, retired from clinical practice after 44 years and became Professor Emeritus



Jerome (Jerry) Goldstein, MD

November 4, 1935 – July 13, 2019



-
- Inducted as an Active Fellow in 1983 and elevated to Emeritus Fellowship in 2002
 - Residency training in Otolaryngology completed in 1968 with Medical Degree earned at the State University of New York
 - Professional career as Assistant Professor at Northwestern University Medical School
 - Entered private practice in Glen Falls, NY in 1971
 - Returned to academia as Professor of Surgery and Head of Albany Medical College Division of Otolaryngology for nine years
 - Recognized as renowned Otolaryngology surgeon led to distinguished career in surgery, teaching and administrative leadership
 - Career in public service with leadership roles as Executive Vice President of the AAO-HNS for 10 years; President of the AHNS; ABOto; Triological Society; and Chairperson of the COSM Secretaries Liaison Committee
 - AAO-HNS established the Jerome C. Goldstein MD Public Service Award to annually commemorate his commitments to improve patient welfare



Arndt J. Duvall III, MD

January 14, 1931 - October 28, 2019

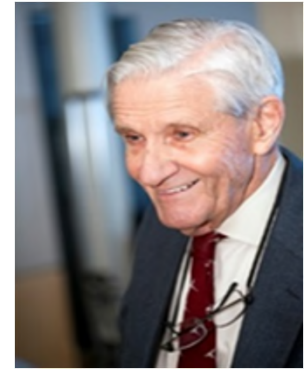

- Inducted as an Active Fellow in 1973 and elevated to Emeritus Fellowship in 1993
 - Medical Degree earned at the University of Minnesota Medical School
 - Successful clinical physician, surgeon and professor of Otolaryngology at University of Minnesota
 - Member of several state and national associations including the Triological Society, American Otological Society, and the American Board of Otolaryngology



M. Stuart Strong, MD

January 28, 1924– November 6, 2019



- Inducted as an Active Fellow in 1975 and elevated to Emeritus Fellowship in 1990
- Completed residency training in Otolaryngology Dublin, Ireland (1950) and the Lahey Clinic in Boston (1952) and a Diploma of Laryngology & Otology at the Royal College of Physicians of England
- Named Chair at Boston Univ. School of Medicine Dept. of Otolaryngology in 1956 followed by Chief of OTO (University Hospital) and Director of OTO at Boston City Hospital. Served in all positions until 1985
- In 1968, joined with Dr. Chasin to form the BU-Tufts Combined Training Program in Otolaryngology for 25 years
- Collaborated with Drs. Jako, Vaughan, and Polanyi to develop use of carbon dioxide laser to treat upper aerodigestive tract disease that improves the lives of countless patients.
- Served as presidents of the ALA (1982); Triological Society, ABEA and SUO
- Was a model of professionalism & compassion
