Those wishing to compete for this Award must submit their entry on an American Laryngological Association abstract form followed by the submission of a manuscript by the designed deadline. The winner of the Award will be chosen by a committee and the Casselberry Award will be presented at the Annual Scientific Meeting.

Steering Committee members presenting papers at the podium will recuse themselves from the voting process.

Announcement of the recipient would be at the end of the annual meeting by the PGM Steering Committee. The winner would also be announced in the ALA newsletter.

A plaque will be created and sent to the recipient along with a check for the monetary award with the Council determine the actual amount of the award.

The award will be limited to podium presentations, however, future expansion of the award to include a separate poster category may be possible based on additional ALA Council interest and funding for the award.
